**ORDINANCE NO. 113-36A**

**AMENDMENT TO LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE**

**Title**

An Ordinance amending the Armada Township Liquor Control Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 113-36A, to provide that the Liquor Control Enforcement Department of the Township shall consist of at least one Armada Village Police Officer rather than a Macomb County Sheriff Deputy or Constable, and repealing all ordinances and/or resolutions in conflict therewith.

**THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMADA, MACOMB COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:**

**Section 1. Amendment.**

Section 4 (Enforcement) of the Armada Township Liquor Control Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 113-36A, shall be repealed and the following substituted therefor:

For the purpose of the enforcement of the Michigan Liquor Control Code within the Township, there is hereby established a liquor control enforcement department with full power, authority and duty to see that the provisions of the act and the rules and regulations of the state liquor control commission, adopted pursuant to the act, are enforced within the Township. Such department shall consist of not less than one (1) Armada Village Police Officer appointed by the Township Board and such other personnel as the Township Board may, in its discretion, appoint. The personnel in such department shall be entitled to such compensation as the Township Board may determine. Such department or a member thereof shall be available at all times to investigate complaints received under this Ordinance, and enforce its provisions.

**Section 2. Severability.**

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of said section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not effect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 3. Publication.**

A true copy of this Ordinance or summary thereof shall be published in The Armada Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the Township of Armada.

**Section 4. Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication of a true copy or summary thereof as provided in Section 3.
